HISTORY

- **Founded immediately after World War II, it was a secondary school specialising in scientific studies and did not guarantee entry to all university studies.**
- **A parallel course specialising in classical languages was founded in 1948.**
- **In 1993 a new parallel course specialising in modern languages followed.**



On 11th December, 1969 the school was named after France Prešeren, the Slovene national poet.



He was one of the greatest European Romantics.

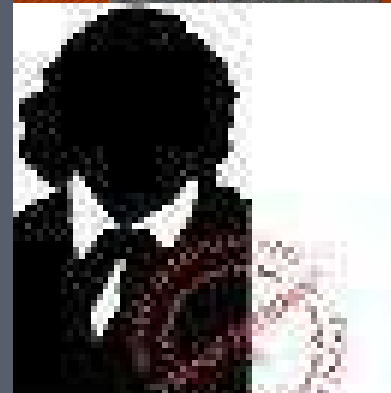
