Dominik Primus (Hagrar HAK – Althofen)





Caveng-Bernhard Nicole (Hagrar HAK – Althofen)




I interviewed a girl from Agrar Hak in Althofen. Her name is Nicole. She is a pretty girl, very tall and she has got long blonde hair.

Ines Engler (Hagrar HAK – Althofen)




Ines was my partner during the school exchange: a very nice and friendly girl!


